

SUFFOLK LINKS DEMAND RESPONSIVE TRANSPORT

BUZABOUT

Suffolk Links is a demand responsive transport service which provides connections to bus and train links in rural areas

Suffolk Links Buzabout is a service for **anyone of any age** at the cost of a bus fare. The daytime service is free to valid Concessionary Bus Pass holders between 9.30 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. Mondays to Fridays and all day until 7.00 p.m. Saturdays. Young People under 14 pay two-thirds fare excluding under 5's who travel free. The evening service is being supported by some local Parish Councils, Suffolk ACRE and Suffolk County Council and special fares apply.

The new 11 seater minibus will be wheelchair friendly but please advise the operator when booking if you have a wheelchair or scooter. Baby and child booster seats are provided for the transport of children up to the age of 12 years or 135cm (4ft 4") in height.

Use it to go to the local shops and pubs, to the doctors or to see friends on the Shotley Peninsula or to connect with a train or bus at Ipswich/Manningtree Stations. Evening services can extend to Cardinal Park, Princes Street and the Old Cattle Market Bus Station in Ipswich.

Suffolk Links Buzabout operates between the following hours:-

Monday	7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
Tuesday	7:00 a.m. to Midnight
Wednesday/Thursday	7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
Friday/Saturday	7:00 a.m. to Midnight

The Dial-A-Ride wheelchair friendly minibus provides a Door to Door Supermarket Service, on alternate Mondays, for Shotley Peninsula Residents unable to use Public Transport due to Mobility Problems, Age, Frailty etc.

Morning and Afternoon Services to
Sainsbury's - Hadleigh Road (£3.70), Tesco's - Copdock (£3.70),
Asda and Morrison's (£6.50).
